The wMu needs your help for a mission opportunity experience. We are collecting school supplies for a giveaway scheduled for August 8th from 8am to 10am. We are going to open this up to the community to come and receive school supplies for free.

This is going to be a big undertaking, but we know that the IBC family gives so generously for missions and this will be a great witnessing opportunity for our community and our local children. Missions Race Day collections totaled \$1,135.87 towards the Clifford Compton Associational Mission Fund -- The Koinonia, Wee Folk, and Snuggles classes gave the most at \$320.00.
